is a sober-living housing environment on Cleveland's east side. It is specially designed for

men going through the re-entry process.

Each Open Door resident has his own bedroom and shares a kitchen and bathroom with one or two residents in their suite. The suites/housing units are equipped with the essentials needed for a comfortable, stable living space. The Open Door floor is supervised and monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

## Eligibility

*To be eligible for the Stokes Mall Open Door Program, residents must meet the following criteria:*

- Male, formerly incarcerated, currently homeless, 18 years or older, released within the past 24 months
- Has entered Cuyahoga County from an Ohio correctional institution or social/human service agency (including—but not limited to—any of the following: a county jail, halfway house or transitional controlled facility)
- Does not have a previous criminal history related to methadone, or any other infractions determined by CMHA to make individuals ineligible for public housing
- Has received a minimum of three months of core services *[including—but not limited to—any of the following: assessment(s), a wrap/treatment plan, active engagement with a case manager]* prior to being referred
- Has completed an Open Door referral packet, submitted by the applicant's case manager
- Assigned to a case manager for the entire duration of residency at Open Door
